

Students - incoming mobilities within Erasmus+ (Key action 1 – KA 131)

As of March 28th 2024

General information

Incoming students who intend to take up studies at the Białystok branch of the Academy of Dramatic Art in Warsaw ought to represent a field of study related to the physical form theatre. The students who don't represent the field of study related to the physical form theatre, can be admitted only for the winter term or for the whole academic year.

Application documents

Incoming students shall submit application through the electronic system (SMS mobilities) or send a set of documents to the e-mail address of the Erasmus+ Programme Coordinator at the Branch Campus in Białystok consisting of:

- an official nomination issued by the home university (with clear indication of the grant awarded), The nominations shall be sent through an official email of the sending university/HEI (International coordinator email/ Departmental Coordinator/ Responsible Person) or through the electronic system via EWP if the electronic systems of the sending and receiving institutions allow it.
- an application form (to be downloaded from the website),
- CV,
- an artistic portfolio including at least one video or video link with the presentation of artistic realizations in line with the field of study,
- transcript of records issued by the home university

An online interview may be conducted with a given candidate prior to the final decision regarding acceptance.

Application deadlines

- a) Deadline for students' nominations from home university:
- May 15th for the following autumn semester or full academic year,
 - October 15th for spring semester of the given academic year.
- b) Deadline for students' application:
- May 31st for autumn semester of the following academic year or full academic year,
 - October 30th for spring semester of the given academic year.

The applications for winter term 2024/2025 can be submitted from May 4th 2024 to May 31st 2024.

The applications for summer term 2024/2025 can be submitted from October 3rd 2024 to October 31st 2024.

Please do not send the applications before the above mentioned dates.

In a given semester number of places at the Academy for incoming students is limited.

The Academy may accept some late nominations in case of a late selection by the Partner University but would like to be informed in advance.

In exceptional situations and in the case of a lower interest than the number of places available, the Academy has the right to admit a candidate after the application deadline.

Language requirements

The Academy does not have separate programmes carried out entirely in English. Incoming students join the classes with local students. The language of instruction is Polish, consultation in English.

The Academy does not ask for any language certificate, however the Academy expects their partners to select students according to the language requirements: **English at B2 level and/or Polish at B2 level**
