The academic year	<p>A detailed organization of the academic year is established by the rector after seeking Senate's advice and announced not later than 30th June. The academic year lasts from 1st October till 30th September of the following calendar year (9 months). The academic year is divided into two semesters. Each semester lasts 15 weeks and ends with examination session. Winter examination session takes place in the second part of January, resits are taken usually until 01.03 (dates are established on individual terms). Summer examination session takes place in the first part of June. Resits are taken usually until 30th September. Intermission between semesters lasts 1 week. 3-month summer holidays begin after summer examination session and last until 1st October.</p>

The students who don't represent the field of study related to the physical form theatre, can be admitted only for the winter term or the whole academic year.</p> <p>The language of instruction is Polish.
